Abriendo Puertas/Opening Doors approached our program, Engaging Latino Communities in Education (ENLACE), about the possibility of hosting a training for a variety of early childhood related programs across New Mexico. The mothers that participated through Más Mama were able to really understand the stages of child development presented in the 'How My Child Grows' section because the activities were so engaging. Abriendo Puertas/Opening Doors enables the facilitators and the parents to enter into a dialogue so that the parents can absorb new information in a way they can relate to. It is not just the theory but the exercises that help the parents expand their horizons as their child's first teacher.

We fully support the efforts of Abriendo Puertas/Opening Doors as it is a program that truly increases parents' ability, knowledge and tools to teach their children. The consequences will benefit our students, parents and the community at large.
